

The Basics

The rules are the same as the adult Dorchester and District League (see attached pdfs in 'Information' section) except for the following:

- -All matches start at 18:15. Any Club failing to be ready by 18:25 shall be deemed to have lost the toss
- -Bowlers can bowl a maximum of 4 overs
- -Players must be 18 or younger on the 31 August of the competition year.
- -Result sheets to be returned (post/email) to either Rachel or myself within 72 hours of the completion of the game
- -All clubs must provide a scorer
- -It is the responsibility of the home club to arrange the home fixture during the groups stages and inform the league of the agreed date.
- -The young player regulations are applicable.
- -Players can only play for one side in the under 18 competition. 11 players must be registered before the first game using the enclosed player registration sheet. Rule 20a is then used for additional registrations
- -There is a cost to enter this competition and payment, along with player registration sheet should be sent to Rachel or me before a club's first game.
- -Games should be 20 overs. Please refer to rule 29 for further information
